The countdown is on - album release 6 September 2024

Bischofszell, August 2024 - Eastern Swiss modern rock band Pilots of the Daydreams are releasing their second album. The new album "Invented Paradise" with ten original compositions embodies the band's creative vision and independence and marks the next milestone in their career. The album, a musical fusion of heavy, modern and progressive rock, will be released on 6th September 2024.

Since their formation in 2019, the band from Eastern Switzerland has achieved a lot - their debut album 'Angels Are Real' was released in 2021 and has already received international recognition from the music press. The band has received airplay on various radio stations in Switzerland and neighbouring countries. Other highlights include In July 2023, the band opened for Canadian prog rock legends SAGA at the Konzertfabrik Z7 in Prattlen, Switzerland. In September 2023, the band from eastern Switzerland released their new single "Butterfly In Your Heart" - a darkly romantic rock song with chart potential and an accompanying music video - the first song to herald the new album.

A fusion of heavy, modern and progressive rock

For the new album, the three musicians Marco Predicatori (vocals/guitar), Walo Bortoletto (bass) and Biagio Anania (drums) used the whole year 2023 to write ten new compositions. The creative process resulted in a fusion of heavy, modern and progressive rock. The lyrics deal with the unfulfilled wishes, dreams and goals of people who find themselves in a fantasy world.

Some of the lyrics are autobiographical, others have a broader thematic focus. "At its core, the album is an ode to the dreams that inspire us and to the inner strength to make them come true, no matter how high they are set," says singer Marco Predicatori. With the ten songs on their new album, the band creates a world where reality and fantasy merge, taking music lovers on an emotional journey.

The production was realised by experienced studio engineer Andreas Vetterli at the Migou Soundpool in Flawil and completed in April this year. Another highlight was the video clip for the album release, which was also realised in June with Frank Kolbrenner and his experienced team from Musikclip in Näfels.
